



Try Something Different, Learn Something New

Open Water Side Mount Pool Demo Friday Feb 26

Diving side mount is not a new concept, originally created by cave divers that had a need to safely penetrate narrow and confining spaces. The next step was towards the open water diver. Much of the interest was created by the way the divers was able to divide the weight of the gear. Preparing for a dive is different. The diver can carry the cylinders to the waters edge and leave them there. After suiting up in the appropriate thermal protection the divers wears a harness/air cell combination that is independent of the cylinders. Upon entering the water the divers then attaches the cylinders to the harness. Hose routing is completely different from what is normally seen since each tank is responsible for different tasks.

Trying the Nomad system is the best way to learn and increase knowledge levels. Participants will need their own Towel, Bathing Suit, Exposure Protection if required, Mask and Fins. Dive Rite will supply Nomad Systems including Tanks and Regulators.
